



Behavioural Expectations during Online Learning

- Children should register at the start of each day and should attend all subsequent online sessions at the directed times
- All assignments set through the day should be completed with work submitted when requested by the teacher (*see the 'Accessing files and assignments on TEAMS' section for help with this*)
- Children should only use apps and resources as directed by their teacher and should only upload material that is related to their learning.
- Children should not take photos of their screen or record videos or interactions in any way.
- Children should make sure that any communication during online learning is always related to their learning and the learning and wellbeing of others. They should be polite at all times, including when using the chat function.
- During any live sessions, parent / carers should be present in the room or in the next room with the door open so they can see and hear everything that is happening during the live session.
- During live sessions, children should have their cameras on and microphones muted, unless they are answering or asking a question (*please see the 'Accessing live lessons via Teams' document for help with this*)
- If taking part in a live session, children should aim to make sure that:
 - their environment is quiet and free from distractions
 - the background should be blurred (please see the 'Accessing live lessons via Teams' document for help with this)
 - they are appropriately dressed (no need to be in school uniform!)
 - they should remain attentive and play an active role in lessons
- Just like in class, children should use the 'hands up' button when they want to speak and will try not to talk over anyone else – the teacher will be able to mute if needed (please see the 'Accessing live lessons via Teams' document for help with this)
- The teacher reserves the right to remove children from the session if they see/hear anything that contravenes the Home User Agreement.
- ***Parents/Carers, please remember that by your child logging into online learning, you and they are agreeing to abide by the Home User Agreement signed prior to them receiving their iPad.***
