This term, we will continue our practise of the four operations. We will be recapping fractions, decimals and percentages and looking at different kinds of graphs and charts. We will be reading 'Stormbreaker' by Anthony Horowitz this term and we will be doing lots of work on tenses and description. We will also be reading different texts every week which will link to our topic, such as information texts about London and Queen Elizabeth II. We are going to be learning about the history of London in preparation for our trip to London in March, covering things like the Great Fire of London, World War II and different monarchs.
