### Letters and Sounds

Since the beginning of the year, the children have been learning the letter sounds below. Please can you work with your child to write the letters using the formation rhymes to support them. For example, 'around the apple and down the leaf'. This will really support them with their writing as they move into Reception.

a Around the apple and down the leaf.	b Down the leaves to the heel and around the toe.	c Curl around the caterpillar.	d Around the dinosaur's bottom up his tail and down to his toes.	e Lift off the top and scoop out the egg.	f Down the stem and draw the leaves.
g Around the girl's face, down her hair and give her a curl.	h Down the head, to his hooves and over his back.	i Down the body and dot for the head.	j Down his body, curl, dot for his head.	k Down the kangaroo's body tail and leg.	l Down the long leg.
m Down Masha, Mountain, Mountain.	n Down Nobby and over to me.	o All around the orange.	p Down the giraffe's tail and around the face.	qu Round her head, up and her quacking, down her hair and tail.	r Down the robot's back and out over his arm.
