Enquiry question: Why do things change?




Geography: We will be learning how to look at digital and paper maps, read map symbols, draw and sketch maps of our own and use a compass. We will be learning about our place in the world and know where Bristol and the UK are in relation to other cities, other countries and other continents.

Science: We are looking at what makes us human. We will be exploring what our skeleton and muscles do. We will also look at how to stay healthy and what a balanced diet is. We will learn what vertebrates and invertebrates are.
