Maths:

This term we will be looking at measuring length in metres and cm as well as solving problems involving length. We will also be recapping previous learning about calculations, time and money.

You can help your child at home by practising the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

English:



This term we will be using the stories 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane' in our literacy lessons. We will be working on writing in the past tense, adding suffixes to the ends of words and adding detail to our writing. We will be writing a recount and a description this term using those skills. You can help your child at home by supporting them to learn their weekly spellings.

Enquiry: How is Bristol taking flight?

This term we will be developing as historians. We will be studying the history of flight in Bristol. Exploring the Bristol Aeroplane Company, the Concorde and Airbus. We will be developing our observation and comparison skills while exploring the very first flight in the UK and the far more modern planes of today.

In Art we will be developing our painting skills while learning about the art style of Robert Delauney.
