


# Class Newsletter– Reception Summer Term 6

### Maths

This term the children will be learning about numbers within 20, and how we can compare groups and add one more or less.

To help at home: please help your child counting to 30 and counting backwards from 20.

Try counting on from different numbers on a number line!



### Literacy

This term our class text is 'Argghhhh Spider!' by Lydia Monks. The children are going to look at different animals and write about what their dream pet would be!

To help at home: practise writing sentences using known sounds. The children have been practicing writing their sentences - so let them show you what they can do!



### P.E

This term, Reception are working on their ball skills through throwing, catching, bouncing, rolling and kicking! This term reception has P.E lessons on a **Tuesday**, so please ensure your child is wearing their PE kit to school on this day. As the weather gets warmer we have started to use the field for some P.E lessons so please make sure that your child has a pair of trainers on!



### Summer time!

As the weather gets warmer we would like to remind you that children need to bring in their water bottle **everyday** and that this should be filled with water and not juice. This should also be named.

As appropriate could you make sure your child has sun cream applied each morning before school and that children have their shoulders covered.
