Maths:

This term we will be looking at collecting and recording data in different ways, exploring shapes, patterns, lines and turns as well as measuring capacity and volume.

You can help your child at home by practising the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

English:



This term we will be using the stories 'The start of something big' in our literacy lessons. We will be working on using verbs and adverbs in our writing, adding suffixes to the ends of words and adding detail to our writing. We will be writing an adventure story this term. You can help your child at home by supporting them to learn their weekly spellings.

Enquiry: How is Bristol taking flight?

This term we will be continuing to develop as historians. We will be studying the history of flight in Bristol. Exploring the Bristol Aeroplane Company, the Concorde and Airbus. We will also be finding out about the Bristol International Balloon Fiesta.

In DT we will be learning about the structure of kites, designing and making our own. Which we will test out on our visit to the beach in July.
