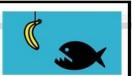

Despite the weather we had another amazing week last week. During celebration assembly we heard about all the brilliant achievements of children and teach-



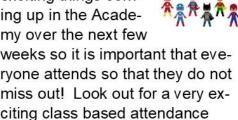
ers from across the Academy and Badgers won the weekly attendance prize for highest attendance of 96.6%.
